Note made that the price of the Homecoming Tickets has changed from what was reported in the meeting minutes.

Motion to approve (with note about change to ticket cost): Kristin Grimm, Second: Carter Grimm. None opposed. Minutes approved.

Principals report:

- Awareness - Student Council and nine choir members attended and spoke/ performed at the School Board Meeting and spoke about their experience and their school spirit. They did a great job.
- Courtyard – completion goal of end of the semester. Expecting weekly updates. Turf completed. Ideally would have a grand opening in January.
- Academic – PSAT and SAT took place 10/13/2021 for all 9th and 10th grades as well as 11th grade opt in.
- Student Center – is open for lunches with students eating, playing games and hanging out/ being social. The students are taking pride in the space to keep it pristine.

Unfinished Business:

- SAC Funding Balance \$6,944
- Request One – Beth McCallister (Anatomy Club) for dissection materials that is above the standard science course curriculum and this club provides for an extension of classroom learning. Amount requested \$592. Carter Grimm, motion to approve, Crystal Rockne, second. All in favor. Approved request.
- Request Two – Pamela Mayle (Reading Teacher) soliciting for funding to purchase ACT/ SAT assessments for seniors to meet their reading concordant for graduation. Each test of \$55 and tests are administered on the weekends. 8 additional staff requested SIP funds to support the overall goal. Request for this round is half of the total year expectation \$2,000. Motion to approve, Kristin Grimm, Tiffany Davies second. All in favor. Approved funding.
- Request Three – Crystal Rockne (Senior Celebrations) looking for funding for prizes and giveaways for senior celebrations and activities. Will be used to purchase: blankets, candles, organizing bins, school supplies, “dorm” gear. Motion to approve, Robert Florio, Kristin Grimm, second. All in favor. Approved funding.
