 - Wins

 - Increased evidence of lesson planning are teachers Level 1? Level 2? Level 3?
 What is the student experience from class to class? How do we maintain/increase student engagement as opposed to compliance?
 - Growth opportunities
 - Literacy/reading/rigor
 - Meaningful collaboration cadence
 - Monitor for learning
