Principal's report a/k/a State of the Royal Court Report:

- **Top 10 students** – valedictorian (Griffin F.) salutatorian (Matthew J.) 3rd highest (Carter G.) All received sashes/ certificates, will get a continental breakfast with family.
- **Robotics** – competed week of March 12th. Won 2nd place award for design. Especially significant achievement considering it is a club and not a school program. The robot was assessed on ingenuity, functionality, and design (to earn the award). Accomplishment is based on more than just building a robot.
- **District Drill Championship** – Won. 2nd year in a row and have won 4 of the last 5 out of 16 teams.
- **Leaders in Me Program** – based on Steven Covey's 7 successful habits series and is a school-based program that will be implemented in the 24/25 year. To include :30/ day spent on project-based learning outcomes where 20-25 mixed grade groups will determine a project and program to implement to improve the school. Supported by a teacher. Some projects could include: teacher appreciation, school beautification, improving school culture. Will focus on skills such as leadership, time management and career readiness. 10-12 High Schools in the district are expected to implement. A group of students attended a summit in February with the Superintendent and came back to present the concept to staff.
- **Academic Team** – finished 3rd, highest for Hollins ever. 1st St Pete, 2nd East Lake, 3rd Hollins.
