Meeting Minutes:

Meeting called to order: 6pm

Motion to approve prior meeting minutes: Nidia Quartararo 2nd: Chris Rogers. Motion carried.

Principals report:

Scholastic Arts Regions Awards: 4th highest High School in district with entries earning gold keys. Total awards: 6 Golds, 6 Silver and 14 Honorable mentions. In the district, Gibbs had 15 gold, Largo had 11 and Palm Harbor had 8

Staffing: 3 vacancies have been filled (Art, Business, ESE/ESOL/ Reading

Graduation Rate: 97.1% - highest in schools history (went from 77 to 85 to 93 to 97) with year over year gains. Pinellas County is #1 district in the State.

Holiday Show: Performing arts have had to perform without audiences and with masks on. Held a free show in the parking lot that was well attended including dance, choral, band and musical theater

Spring Plan: Families can return if they choose. Of the 1,879 students enrolled, < 600 are currently virtual. (Parent Suggestion: open windows and doors to adjust for increased number of students in smaller space) Mr. Florio shared that opening windows is against Marjory Stoneman Douglas Act and keeping students safe from other threats. Also shared the school received a upgraded filtration system. Class sizes could increase to 26-30

Unfinished Business: Collection of \$25-\$50 Amazon gift cards as incentive for seniors who attend additional tutoring as they work towards getting their concurrent test scores needed for graduation.

New Business: None

Open Forum: Parent (Nidia Quartararo) asked if guidance could provide more support to the High School seniors who are not currently in AVID. Discussion around measures that could be taken to increase the support to the students who don't have a lot of support with next steps.

Parent (Chris Rogers) suggested a step by step list for getting into college (what needs to happen)

Mr. Florio acknowledged that a commitment will be made to focus on the bridge from high school graduation to college/ trade

Parent (Orlando Acosta): funding request \$400 for class set of headsets (at \$30 each). Motion to approve: Nidia Quartararo, 2nd: Chris Rogers. All in favor.
