- Staff Performance/ Recognitions
 - Candace Metcalf – District (all levels) administrator of the year and is now entered into the State competition.
 - Teacher of the Year – Ms. August
 - Support Personnel of the Year – Mr. Dix
 - Emerging Teacher – Ms. Austin
 - Voting included soliciting staff feedback and votes.
- School is fully staffed!!!
- SIP (School improvement plan)
 - Biology is up 1 point, 10th grade reading is down, geometry is up 4 points, algebra has maintained, 9th grade English is up 4 points and history is up 4 points.
 - Feeling good about the upward trend in these performance measures
 - Using a focus on learning communities is working well.
- The District Event with the Superintendent (Listen & Learn) was most highly attended in recent events, there was catered food, a report on student experience and some questions and answers from the superintendent. Was well received and showcased Hollins well.
