REMEMBER THE TRANSITION PROCESS

- A student will be eligible to "roar back to success"/Go back to their home school, as evidenced by meeting the 4 A's.
- The MTSS team will review student progress to determine if a student has successfully completed the 4 A's criteria (32pts).
- If a student has not successfully meet the 4 A's criteria for transition, they will remain a PSS until the next review period.

WHAT CAN YOU BRING TO SCHOOL?

• An open mind and a willingness to learn.

 Pen, Pencil, Paper, Folders and a Binder (Open/Close Only - No Zip Arounds).
 Clear Pencil Bags are acceptable

• PSS provides <u>FREE</u> breakfast/lunch for <u>ALL</u> students

 Lunch brought on campus must be in a clear plastic bag with your name on it.
 All drinks must have an unbroken seal.



No BACKPACKS, PURSES, GYM BAGS, MAKE-UP or non-clear PENCIL BAGS

No GUM and SUNFLOWER SEEDS or LARGE BAGS OF CHIPS/CANDY

No food or drinks allowed outside of cafeteria

NO TOUCH POLICY

Pinellas Secondary School is a <u>NO Touch School</u>

POLO STYLE SHIRT: LONG OR SHORT SLEEVES



IN DRESS CODE POLO SHIRT

- 1.Student must wear only traditional, non-fitted, solid polo style shirt.
- 2.These shirts must have NO pockets, printing, embroidery, or designs on them.
- 3.If you wear a undershirt, it must be plain black (HS) or white (MS), and both *must be tucked in*.
- 4.Long sleeves or full short sleeves (no cap sleeves).



- Only plain black sweatshirts for high school and white sweatshirts for middle school-with NO hoods, pockets, zippers, printing or design may be worn in school.
- •You must be in dress code under your sweatshirt. White or black collared shirts must be visible.
- •Jackets and coats are allowed but must be hung up on coat racks upon arrival to school. Students may retrieve jackets at the end of the day.

PANTS: DRESS CODE

Only relaxed fit KHAKI pants are allowed. There may be NO -- printing, embroidery, logos, designs, Cargo pants, shorts, jeans, corduroy, jeggings, jersey, skinny jeans, tight fitting pants or oversized pants.

 Pants must have belt loops and a belt on at all times.

• All pants must be hemmed and MUST be worn at the waist. No SAGGING!!

RELAXED FIT KHAKI PANTS

• Khaki Pants/ Loose Fitting





- A simple, plain BLACK or BROWN belt, with a simple, traditional buckle must be worn.
- Except for buckle, there may be no other metal on the belt.
- NO large or ornate belt buckles are allowed.



SHOES: BLACK, BROWN, GRAY, OR WHITE



SHOES: DRESS CODE

- Shoes must be black, white, gray or brown sneakers or dress shoes. A combination of these colors may be worn.
- No sandals, slippers, boots or other work style shoes.
- Laces should match the main color of the shoe (absolutely no colored laces or soles.)





- Students may NOT wear or bring any rings, bracelets, necklaces, earrings, watches or any other jewelry to school. This includes tongue and face piercings and spacers/gauges, bandages, etc...
- If a student brings any of these items to school, the items will be confiscated until a parent can pickup these item(s).

ELECTRONIC DEVICES

•Cell phones are required to be checked in at the beginning of the school day and before you enter the building.

Must be turned off when placed in the folder

 Ankle monitors cannot be charged on campus

ID BADGES - - -

- Students are required to wear an ID Badge as part of the Dress Code Policy. Each student will be given an ID Badge when they enroll into Pinellas Secondary School.
- Lost, broken, destroyed, or defiled ID Badges must be replaced, to be in dress code compliance, at a charge of \$1.00 each.
