ACADEMIC EXCELLENCE THROUGH INNOVATION



OUR GOALS:

Support increased educational innovation by continuing to reduce regulations for public school districts to better align with other K-12 charter, home school and private institutions that also receive state and/or federal funding. (SB166(2025))

Enhance the investment in academic, developmentally appropriate, high-quality early learning and Voluntary Prekindergarten (VPK) to include free, full-day academic programs and experiences for students eligible for free/reduced lunch.

Align rules and guidelines for district-operated virtual programs regarding the ability to report FTE beyond the 180-day school year with those already in place for Florida Virtual School.

OUR GOALS:

Allocate funding streams that accurately reflect the costs associated with delivering high-quality School Safety and Mental Health services.

To ensure instructional continuity following a natural disaster, consider establishing a zero-interest contingency or emergency loan program to support school districts in hurricane or disaster recovery efforts.

OUR GOALS:

Allow rigorous, in-demand Career Technical Industry Certifications to serve as a concordance for high school graduation assessment requirements; concordant certifications to be identified by the Florida Department of Education.

Expand workforce development and dual enrollment in high-demand career programs to meet Florida's talent needs by modernizing Pinellas Technical College's St. Petersburg campus through a state capital investment, enhancing its appeal and functionality as a high-quality postsecondary institution.

Continue to fund in full the Academic Acceleration Options Supplement to ensure consistent access to advanced and accelerated courses and exams, while also recognizing effective teachers whose students achieve these outcomes.

Positive Experiences

POSITIVE STAFF EXPERIENCES THROUGH FISCAL AND OPERATIONAL RESPONSIBILITY OUR GOALS:

Separate allocations for state scholarships and vouchers for parents from the FEFP to ensure transparency regarding public school district funding. (SB 7030 (2025))

In order to attract and retain staff, increase the flexible funds for general operating dollars (Base Student Allocation) to sufficiently fund the escalating costs of school districts which include employee salaries, benefits, and mandatory employer contributions to the Florida Retirement System.
