## SL Biology 2

### IA Preliminary Submission

**DUE AUGUST 12<sup>th</sup> by 11pm to ManageBac**

*State your research question. It should be \*fully focused\*. Complete the following:*

1. Sufficient, RELEVANT background research. Use the exploration criterion in the IA rubric (*in your student manual*) as a guide. Resources should be cited here. **(1 page minimum)**
2. A ***detailed*** description of your procedure including sampling methods and type of data collected. This must be specific! Be sure to include any safety, ethical and/or environmental concerns.
3. Blank data tables with titles, heading units, and uncertainties where appropriate. Remember, you need to collect *\*sufficient\** data. The 5x5 model-five conditions with five replicates-is the minimum. Some investigations will require a larger sample size.
4. A description of all statistical tests that you plan to use analyze your data. This should include the name of the test, the formula(s), a description of how you will use it in YOUR investigation, and one same (hypothetical) calculation. Examples include standard deviation, chi-squared, t-test, regression and correlation. Refer to the statistical analysis handout for guidance. *\*Formulas and sample calculations are required.\**
