WEIGHTED GRADES:

Effective for students who entered 9th grade in the 2014-15 school year and beyond, Pre-IB, MYP, and all Honors classes carry 0.5 weighted quality points (half weight). Only courses that require students to take a test at the end of the course- that could earn college credit earn a full 1.0 weight. **IB and AP classes receive a full 1.0 weight.**
