



- Malpractice- Behavior that results in gaining an unfair advantage.

- Dismissal- Students will be dismissed for serious disciplinary infractions.



## Academic Guidelines

Membership in the IB program is a privilege. Academic and behavior standards are necessary.

- Students must maintain a 2.69 GPA to stay in the program.
  - Anytime a student falls below the minimum GPA they will receive an "academic alert", be placed on a success plan, and provided an academic advisor.
- Dismissal, End of the Year
  - Less than a 2.69 GPA OR
  - An F in an EOC course OR
  - More than one D in an academic class.
