I hope everyone is doing well and had a wonderful Thanksgiving holiday and break.

This is just a reminder that the St. Pete High Thespians will be performing their Winter Play, *Vintage Hitchcock: A Live Radio Play*, and will stream the production on January 21 and 22 at 7pm. Finally, we are happy to announce that after delays due to COVID-19 and construction, we will be hosting our in-person IB Pinning Ceremony for all IB juniors on January 21, 2021. This year's ceremony will be slightly different because of restrictions and construction, so more specific information will be sent in next week's email after our IB Booster meeting next week to finalize the planning of the event.
