The International Baccalaureate (IB) Diploma Program (DP) is a challenging two-year curriculum, which takes place in the 11th and 12th grades. It leads to a diploma that is widely recognized by the world's leading universities.

The SPHS Pre-Diploma Program (Pre-DP) prepares 9th and 10th grade students for the rigorous IB Diploma Program. Pre-DP students must successfully complete all courses and achieve a 2.69 cumulative, unweighted GPA to be eligible to enter the IB DP.
