- Minutes for the November 2019 meeting were approved: F. Masterson, 1st; D. Lebo, 2nd the motion. - Minutes for the December 2019 meeting were approved: F. Masterson, 1st; T. Kaplan. 2nd the motion.

- There was a discussion around the \$12,000 balance back in October; SRO funding was not counted in that number, so the budget balance seemed to be down to close to \$9K as there was a request made and approved for \$2356.60.

- There was a request made for \$1200. Discussions were surrounding ACT and SAT funding needed for students. A motion was made by T. Kaplan and was seconded by P. Melton. Approved.

- District graduation rates were released at 88% and a memo sent out by Dr. Grego. It was positive news with district being tied for first in the state (large dist.category) and tied with Orange County public schools. SPHS numbers improved to 96.1% with 442 out of 446 students graduating. Discussion surrounded graduation rates by Principal Lebo and she explained how the school is impacted negatively by students moving, those taking the GED, plus several other factors. She explained her procedures and also answered the question on data manipulation.

- Connor Evans brought up that students will be meeting for the first SGA meeting of the year shortly in the month of January.
