


## MISSION OF THE **COLLEGE OF MEDICINE** SUMMER INSTITUTE

The FSU College of Medicine Summer Institute is open to students who have completed their sophomore or junior year of high school. Applicants will be selected on the following criteria:

- **✓** 3.3 grade point average (minimum)
- Performance in college-preparatory math and science course
- Essay (500 word minimum)
- Recommendation from teacher and guidance counselor.

### **PROGRAM COST:**
