Bright Futures Community Service for

Class of 2020 During the COVID-19 Closures

Pinellas County School District has made temporary changes to the Bright Futures process for 2020 graduates during the COVID-19 closures. Seniors will be able to complete activities online and from home, but they still must be through an agency. Additionally, they still need to complete and have approved their Bright Futures Proposal, but it can be digitally signed as can the Bright Futures Log & Reflection form. These fillable forms can be obtained from your school counselor.

In addition, we are still awaiting to hear from the Florida Office of Financial Aid. Currently, they have the following message on their website:

April 15, 2020 - JUNE SAT CANCELLATION: The Department is aware of the cancellation of standardized test dates due to the impact of COVID-19 and social distancing measures. The impact of these measures on initial eligibility requirements are being evaluated. Once a decision has been made, official notification will be sent.

Process:

- 1. Determine where you would like to complete your hours and reach out to the agency to let them know of your interest and make arrangements to complete.
- 2. Complete the Bright Futures Proposal form (2-2602-2) and email the completed form to your Bright Futures Community Service Designee for you school.
- 3. The Community Service Designee will review and let you know if it is acceptable.
- 4. If acceptable, complete your hours with the agency.
- 5. Once your hours are completed, complete the Bright Futures Log & Reflection form (2-2602-3). Once you've completed your part of the form, email the document to the Agency Contact Person to confirm your hours. Please give them the email of your Community Service Designee and direct them to email them the completed form.

We have reached out to agencies in the community who have offered community service opportunities in the past to see if they have any activities that students can do from home. The following have said they do have online/at home opportunities. You don't have to choose from this list if you have another agency that can offer you community service. Regardless of the agency you choose, you still must submit a proposal for approval.
