APPLICATION INSTRUCTIONS

Purpose

The Florida Section American Water Works Association will award up to a \$2,000 scholarship to one eligible student, who intends to pursue a college degree relating to the drinking water industry. The scholarship provides reimbursement of tuition, books, and fees through the College/University Financial Aid Department and is generally disbursed to the school in the fall of the year the scholarship is awarded.

Eligibility

- 1. Applicant must be a high school senior and enrolled in one of the seven counties in the Florida Section American Water Works Association's Region IV: Citrus, Hernando, Hillsborough, Pasco, Pinellas, Polk, or Sumter.
- 2. Applicant must be graduating at the end of the current school year and intends to enroll immediately in the following summer or fall semester at a Florida ABET-accredited college/university.
- 3. Applicant must have a minimum 3.0 grade point average based on a 4.0 system.
- 4. Previous scholarship recipients are not eligible.

Application Process

- 1. Complete the application form.
- 2. Enclose official college application or acceptance letter (as applicable).
- 3. Enclose two letters of recommendation from teachers, administration, or co-workers.
- 4. Enclose a brief letter (300 words) describing your interest in the FSAWWA scholarship.

Selection Process

- 1. Evaluation will be made based on academic performance, community and civic activities, honors, career goals, letters of recommendation, and evidence of leadership, motivation, character, and self-reliance.
- 2. At the option of the scholarship committee, the top five candidates may be telephone interviewed by a member of the scholarship committee.
- 3. Scholarship recipients will be selected by the scholarship committee of the Florida Section American Water Works Association.

Deadline for Submission: Applications must be postmarked no later than midnight, May 15, 2020.



Final Selection:

Committee will make final selection of scholarship awardee by July 1, 2020.
