SPC Summer Class Schedule opens for viewing

Beginning on this day, DE Permission forms can be submitted to the SPC Dual Enrollment office as soon as they are completed.

- The 2019-20 DE Permission form should be used for summer courses.
- If a course is offered for the full-term, that is the only format in which a student can take the course. Otherwise students may take a class in the 8-week sessions.
- Summer class schedule <u>cannot</u> interfere with the current high school schedule.
- Students in EIP for the summer should not be taking additional DE courses.
- Students who have not taken DE classes before should be limited to 1 summer course.
- Students who have taken DE previously can take up to 2 courses. Science lab scheduled with the lecture do not count as a separate course.

April 17 Last day to submit permission form and get registered for summer classes

May 7 Deadline for students to return books from the spring term. Students who do not return books by this deadline will be dropped from summer classes immediately.

May 13 Book pick up 2:00-4:00pm, see notes below

- Students should arrive no later than 3:45pm to insure they can obtain the needed books while the bookstore staff is still present.
- The counselor must provide a copy of the attached book day flyer to the student when the permission form is finalized. I suggest getting the student to sign for it.
- There is no alternate time to pick up and/or order books so if a student is not able to be there, the student MUST have someone else go on their behalf to get their books.
- Students must bring their SPC ID to book day with them in the event anything needs to be ordered from the bookstore.
- If one or more of their books is only available in rental form, they will have to provide a valid credit card in order to obtain the rental. We pay for the rental, but they must put a credit card on file because they are responsible for the cost of the book if it is not returned at the end of the term.
- May 18SPC Summer Classes begin
Full-term classes run May 18-July 24
1st 8-Week Session runs May 18-July 10
2nd 8-Week Session runs June 1-July 24
- May 22 Deadline for students to drop a summer class with no record on the transcript.
