Tutoring could occur inside or outside the school day, depending on student need. **Motion to approve-Denise; 2nd-Sam; voice vote-unanimous** -Discussed but determined not needed at this time-\$300 for Mrs. Foster, new science teacher, for a classroom set of white boards. Ms. Naves has white boards that Mrs. Foster can utilize.

-Started working on fencing/gates around campus.

-Camera system is steadily improving.
