- Parent reports there are concerns in the lunch room with behavior in the lines.

## 6. Reports:

- **Principal: L. Fatolitis (Mr. Skelly)**- April 1<sup>st</sup> completion date is tentative for the auditorium. New bleachers, windscreens, and dugouts for the baseball fields. New bleachers and windscreens for softball fields. Artificial turf for football field is projected soon, as is upgraded wood lockers. Curriculum-PSAT scores expected in December. Counselors will meet with students to go over results. 11<sup>th</sup> grade counselor is working with students in Future Plans. Data reflection for teachers for Level 1 and 2 students. Working on targeting supports for all students. My Unify is a new resource for teachers to learn more about their students. Tardies have reduced due to new system. Dress code is becoming a stronger focus. Program shadowing is underway and continues prior to semester exams. Courtyards are popular among students. New system in place soon to provide additional parent communication. Asked if there has been any recent discussions about a pool. If not, can SAC revisit discussions about this topic? There is a spring date for SAT administration date here at Tarpon that yields a reportable score. The Dec 7<sup>th</sup> SAT is being administered at Tarpon. New science teacher has been hired, starting 11/18/19.
- **Officer Theil**- New tardy policy is working well. Interior fencing request was denied by the district. We are hopefully still for some other secondary fencing. Discussed a solution for student gates. There are some small-scale issues being addressed as a result of construction. The topic of cameras still remains an ongoing discussion between the school and the district. New Baker Act procedures in place that provide proper follow-up care for students. Laws prevent the school from divulging confidential information to staff members. Elaine asked if there is a way for staff to know, as a way to support the student and avoid an overwhelming amount of work upon their return.
