LEARNER ATTRIBUTES

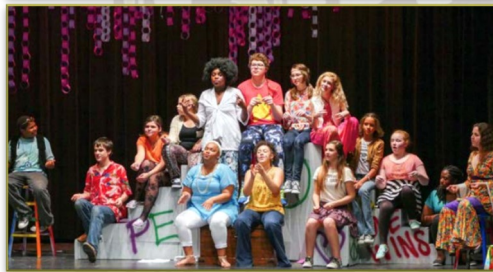
As students progress through the Arts and Multimedia program, they will learn to use these attributes in any school, college, or profession they pursue!
