Based on your results from the Algebra 1 Diagnostic, this tool has been designed to support areas from Pre-Algebra and/or Algebra I for which you need review to ensure your success in Geometry or Algebra II next year.

This summer assignment is <u>REQUIRED</u>. Successful completion of your assignment will count as your first quiz grade.

You will also have an assessment the first week of school similar to the Diagnostic. We encourage you to complete this assignment with fidelity to ensure you are prepared.

This assignment should be completed **WITHOUT** the use of a calculator (unless explicitly stated otherwise in the Khan Academy directions.) <u>You will not be using one on the follow-up assessment.</u>
