



2018-2019 Kindergarten Suggested School Supply List

- Bath size towel (Label with your child's name.)
- Change of clothes (Place in plastic baggy with your child's name on it.)
- Backpack with NO wheels, labeled with child's name on the inside (Large enough to hold a towel and change of clothes.)
- Water Bottle (16 oz. with sport cap)
- 1 one-inch binder
- Snacks (Healthy, enough for 18 children, please make sure they are nut free!)
- Ziploc bags (any size - sandwich, gallon, 2 gallon)
- Crayons (24 count only please)
- Markers (bold in primary colors)
- Glue sticks (please NO bottles)
- Headphones (1-2 pairs of simple black headphones – sold at Walmart for under \$5. Please no large name brand headphones, as they tend to break easily.)

Donations to the classroom are always appreciated. We find that the following items are useful throughout the year.

- Play-dough
- Sidewalk Chalk
- Colored pencils
- Expo dry-erase markers (thin)
- Treasure Box items (small party favors)
- Craft items (craft sticks, wiggly eyes, pom-poms, etc.)
- Watercolor set
- Washable ink pads
- Post-it notes
- Blue painters tape
- Sheet protectors
- Paper towels
- Baby wipes

*Please note: In Kindergarten, we use “community” supplies to learn to share and take care of materials. All supplies will be placed in “community” baskets to be shared with all students in the classroom. Each child is asked to bring in their supplies within the first week of school. Please DO NOT label any of your child's shared supplies. However, please be sure to clearly label your child's backpack, lunchbox, and rest towel with his/her first and last name.
