Progressive Discipline if violation continues

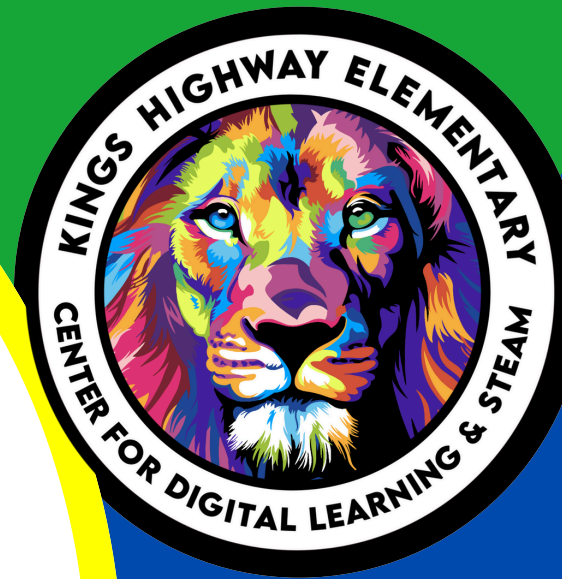
### Dress Code @ KHEMS:
