Can you finish 10 books this summer?</p>	<p>Turn your book into a graphic novel! Recreate the beginning, middle, and end of your story by creating at least 8 illustrations in sequence. Add a sentence with each illustration OR use captions for your characters. Be as creative and colorful as you can!</p>	<p>The expectation is to show mastery of all Kdg, 1st, 2nd, and 3rd grade standards on Dreambox by the end of the year. Use this time to work on any missed standards. Can you complete 50 lessons this summer?</p> 
<p>iStation is a powerful tool to support language learning! Log in & keep working over the summer. Try to complete at least TWO hours each month!</p> <p>Be sure to keep track of your time!</p> 	<p>4th Graders are experts in informational writing. Research a topic that interests you (how Minecraft was created, the history of soccer, the creation of slime, etc). Write an informational essay about your topic.</p>	<p>Ask an adult to help you do a little baking! Choose a recipe that you would like to make. Use the correct measuring spoons/cups to accurately create your mixture. Do your best to do all of the measuring by yourself BUT have an adult take care of the oven. When you are finished, share your treat with your family by serving each family member a "dish."</p>
<p>Think about your favorite book. Rewrite the story and add yourself as a character. How do you add to the storyline? Do you change the story at all?</p>	<p>Think about the many things that you can do in the summer that you can't do during the school year (fall/winter). One owl can carry three Hogwarts messages at a time. If Harry wants to send 48 messages to his friends, how many trips will his owl, Hedwig, need to take?



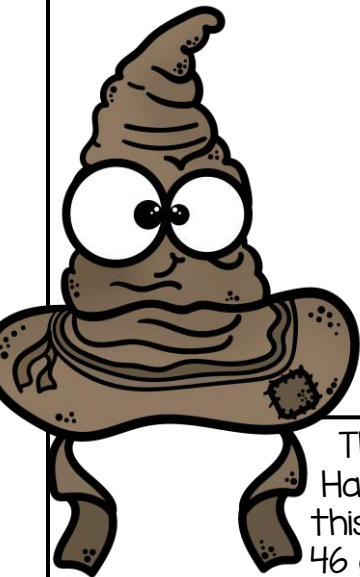
