



3. Pinellas County Schools have adopted Marzano Scale for rating your child's learning goals. Do you understand this system? Two hundred eighty people (90.0%) say they do understand this system. Twenty-five people (8.0%) responded they do not understand this scale. Six people (1.9%) did not respond to this question.



- Are you aware of Garrison-Jones' PRIDE acronym as part of our Positive Behavior System. Two hundred seventy-seven people (89.1%) answered they were aware. nineteen respondents (6.1%) said they were not aware of the PRIDE acronym. Fifteen people (4.8%) did not respond to this question.
- Do you read and encourage your child to use their planner? Two hundred ninety-three people (94.2%) responded that they did.
  Eight people (2.6%) said they did not. Three parents (1.0%) said they did sometimes.
  Seven people (2.3%) did not respond to this question.
- 6. What is the primary source you look to for school events and information? Forty-seven people (12.7%) responded that the School Messenger was their primary source of information. Two hundred fifty-three people (68.2%) said they look in their child's backpack for information. Thirty-four people (9.2%) used Parent Connect as their main source of information. Thirty-one people (8.4%) go to the website first for events and information. Five people (1.3%) say they use all of these sources for information. One person did not answer this question. One person wrote in that they went to Facebook first and one parent said they went to Dojo first for information. Note: school messenger



methods

and parent connect both refer to the automated phone call on Sunday evenings. In total, those responses add up to 81 (21.8%) of the responses.

 Are you aware that Garrison-Jones has a Spanish Immersion program that begins in Pre K? Two hundred sixty-five people (85.2%) responded they were aware. Forty-two people (13.5%) said they were not aware of the program. Four parents (1.3%) did not answer this question.
