### Arrival Procedures

- The car circle and front gate will open at 8:10 AM. Scholars who arrive prior to this time, will not be supervised and should wait in the forest area.
- We will follow the same arrival and dismissal procedures as during the school year. Please remain in your car, in the forest or outside on the sidewalk for dismissal. Only PreK parents may walk to the front. One change: All scholars will enter through the front gate.
- Students may arrive at 8:10 AM and report directly to the café for breakfast. Following breakfast, students will report to their classroom.
