**FREE** After-School STEM Academy Program

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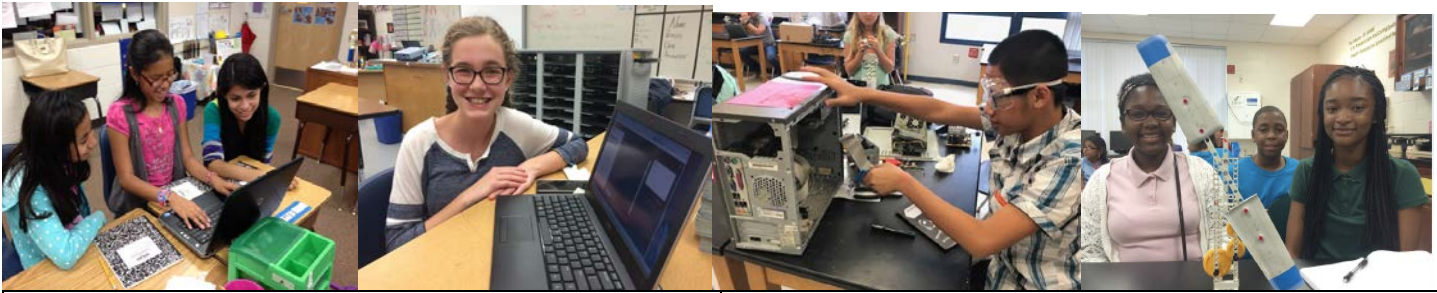
*The VISION of the PCS K-12 STEM Department is to increase STEM opportunities for Pinellas County students, preparing them to excel in STEM fields of study, allowing them to meet the challenges of the global society through innovation, collaboration and creative problem solving.*

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The **FREE** PCS STEM Academy Program will offer your child opportunities to conduct hands-on STEM investigations (following all social distancing guidelines), learn about the engineering design process, improve team building/leadership skills, explore STEM career pathways and interact with community business partners!

## Who?

We are accepting 6<sup>th</sup> through 8<sup>th</sup> grade students. We look for students who work hard, have an interest in STEM concepts and will participate for the full 22 weeks. There is no academic performance requirement, however only 20 students in 4<sup>th</sup> - 12<sup>th</sup> grades can be enrolled into each STEM Academy.

Due to increased demand to participate in this FREE program hosted by the PCS K-12 STEM Department, all students who submit a completed application by December 2nd will get an equal chance at enrollment using the lottery process listed below. Per PCS guidelines, students who are virtually learning from home are permitted to come to the school in order to participate in the STEM Academy Program in-person. No virtual STEM Academy programs or simultaneous teaching is being offered since this program is free and optional.

Completed applications will be collected and divided into two piles (female and male). Using the process of random lottery, 10 females and 10 males (as close as possible) will be selected per STEM Academy. If more than 20 students in both 6-7<sup>th</sup> grades or 8<sup>th</sup> grades apply, remaining students will be placed on a wait list. ALL families will be notified of their status, enrolled or wait listed.

## When?

This 22-week program will begin during the week of December 7<sup>th</sup> and will continue through the week of May 24<sup>th</sup>. Your child's STEM Academy will meet once per week for 60 minutes after school.

STEM Academy at your school will be held on Tuesdays from 4:20 pm to 5:20 pm.

The STEM Academy will be held at your child's school and transportation MUST be provided by the parent/guardian each week. Students will only be permitted to walk/bike home if a parent/guardian is present. Students will not be allowed to walk/bike home without an adult escorting them. If picking your child up by car, you must wait in the car circle and your child will be escorted out by the STEM Academy teacher at 5:20 pm. Please be on time and waiting in the car circle to pick up your child.

## Cost?

The PCS K-12 STEM Department offers the STEM Academy Program at your child's school, FREE of charge.

## What?

During the FREE STEM Academy Program, students will conduct hands-on activities related to STEM concepts (science, technology, engineering and math), explore careers in STEM, complete a STEM engineering design project, learn from business and community partners all while following social distancing guidelines. STEM projects completed by students throughout the year will be displayed during the annual STEM Expo which is scheduled to be held on Saturday, May 15, 2021 at the Pinellas Technical College, St. Petersburg campus.

## Attendance Requirements

Attendance is a critical component to the success of this program considering the amount of work (building, coding, completing challenges, etc.) completed in each week. Due to the overwhelming interest in the STEM Academy Program and the rigor of the planned activities, it is highly suggested that your child tries to attend each session. If your child misses more than 4 unexcused sessions (sick absences are an exception), they will be removed from the academy and replaced by one of the students on the wait list. After the 3<sup>rd</sup> unexcused absence, the STEM Academy teacher will call or speak with you in person to provide an attendance reminder.

## Family Involvement

Later in the year, students enrolled in the STEM Academy Program will receive an invitation to attend and present at the annual FREE STEM Expo that will be held on Saturday, May 15, 2021 at the Pinellas Technical College, St. Petersburg campus. During the 2019 STEM Expo we had more than 3,200 people attend! More information will be provided to families later in the year.
