- 2. Grade point average

Fifth grade students enrolled in the International Baccalaureate Primary Years Programme at James Sanderlin PK-8 IB World School are assured a position at the magnet in the International Baccalaureate Middle Years Programme Candidate School at Sanderlin IB World School provided they complete an application, accept a program invitation by the deadline and meet the middle school eligibility criteria.

TRANSPORTATION

Arterial bus transportation (buses that operate on main roads with a limited number of stops) is provided to students who live more than two miles from the school. Magnet bus stop locations may require that parents drive their children to and from the stop.





Now an IB Middle Years Programme (MYP) Candidate School, our international studies curriculum includes advanced and rigorous course work, while fostering effective listening, problem solving, personal reflection, responsibility, and ethical decision-making. Within a student inquiry framework, students become more culturally aware by exploring current events and real-world issues. An emphasis on traits that develop international-mindedness supports students in finding a sense of belonging in the ever-changing and increasingly interrelated world around them.

Magnet programs focus on a certain theme with specialized curriculum in areas such as arts, communication, science and technology, and gifted studies. Some programs have eligibility requirements. Students living anywhere in the county may apply.

Sanderlin's middle school program provides an intellectually challenging environment that encourages students to become critical and reflective thinkers in preparation for success in college, careers and citizenship in the 21st century global environment. The International Baccalaureate Middle Years Programme is designed to help middle school students find a sense of belonging in the ever-changing and increasingly interrelated world around them and to foster a positive attitude toward learning.

Sanderlin Middle School Course Work

- Language & Literature: Reading Gr. 6 Advanced or Gifted; Language Arts - Gr. 6-7 Advanced and Gr. 8 MYP English 1 (high school credit)
- Language Acquisition: Spanish Required elective Gr. 6-8 (two high school credit options)
- Individuals & Societies (Social Studies): Gr. 6 Ancient Civilizations Advanced, Gr. 7 MYP Civics Advanced; Gr. 8 U.S. History & Career Planning Advanced
- Sciences: Gr. 6-7 Comprehensive Science Advanced, Gr. 8 MYP Integrated Science (high school credit)

- Mathematics (placement based on student achievement data): Math 1 Advanced, Math 2 Advanced, IB Pre-Algebra, IB MYP Algebra 1 (high school credit option), IB MYP Geometry (high school credit option)
- Physical & Health Education: Gr. 6-8 Physical Education (one semester): Gr. 8 Health (one semester)
- Art & Design: Minimum of 1 semester per year in various electives in the Arts & Design

Eight subject groups are integrated through global contexts that provide a framework for learning within and across the subjects. The interdisciplinary nature of this international curriculum helps students build a strong foundation for responsibility and citizenship at the national and global level, encouraging reflective practice that inspires active and responsible participation in their communities.

This interdisciplinary approach emphasizes connections between traditional subjects and the real world. This provides opportunities for individual and collaborative planning and research among students and teachers alike, guiding students to monitor and

direct their own learning through effective decision making, goal setting and time management. Throughout the coursework, students are challenged to solve problems through critical thinking and reasoning skills, show creativity and resourcefulness, and value the importance of lifelong learning.
