
Principal's Message

Ponce Families,

Welcome back! Thank you so much for a fantastic first two weeks of school! My name is Stephanie Blackman and I am so excited to be the new principal of Ponce de Leon Elementary. I have been working for Pinellas County Schools since 2005. I began my career as a classroom teacher at Oakhurst Elementary and in 2012, I became the assistant principal of Southern Oak Elementary. I had the unique opportunity to serve as acting principal for Southern Oak in March of 2016 through the end of the school year. Since coming to Ponce I have already had a great experience meeting the students, parents and staff. I look forward to meeting all of you at Open House! It is scheduled for grades 3-5 (including 2/3 IVE) on Monday, August 23, at 6:30 pm and grades Pre K-2 will be on September 1, at 6:30 pm.

A few changes have been made to Ponce's car circle, which is greatly impacting the flow of traffic coming into the school. We recognize that the change is an inconvenience and we do apologize. We however have been given direction from the city to continue with the changes in the afternoon only. This means that in the morning we will be opening up all entrances to the car circle as it was in the past. However, in the afternoon, it will remain as it is now with all traffic needing to enter by heading north on Betty Lane then making a left turn into school. There are two good options for routes. If you enter the neighborhood via Ponce de Leon Blvd. you can turn right onto Chesterfield Drive, right onto Betty, and left into Ponce Elementary. Another option, from Missouri you can head east on Rosery or Jasper, north onto Betty and left into school. Please see the maps below.

This is my fourth year as the school social worker at our fantastic school, and I am excited to see all of the wonderful things our students will accomplish this year! My role as the school social worker is to collaborate with families, schools, and communities to provide social and emotional support to students, enabling them to learn to the best of their abilities. It is my goal to ensure that all families have access to the resources they need, so that our students can reach their full potential!

One of the easiest ways to support your child’s success, is to ensure that they are attending school, on-time, each and every day. School starts promptly at 8:35am, and every student should be in their seat when the bell rings at this time. This year, you will notice Attendance Awareness posters and banners around our school, to support the Pinellas County School District’s goal of increasing student attendance.

If they are not here, they cannot learn!

Take a look at the Ponce de Leon school website, and you will notice that an icon has been placed in the upper right hand corner that says “Report Student Absence”, to make it even easier for parents and guardians to inform the school of an absence. You can simply click on the icon, then the blue button, which opens a new email where you will enter the Student’s Name, Date of Birth, Grade, Date Absent and Reason for absence. If applicable, you can attach any documentation (i.e. a doctor’s note) to support the absence. Of course, you can continue to call our front office in the morning to notify our school of your child’s absence as well. Included in your Student Code of Conduct is a list of reasons an absence will be considered “excused”. If you have any questions, please feel free to contact me Monday through Friday at our school phone number. I look forward to seeing your child each and every day!
