We are often times not in our office and therefore not able to take phone calls because we are working with students and teachers. Every effort will be made to return your call by the end of business but in the event that it is not possible, we ask that you give use 24 hours to return your call. If your issue requires immediate attention, please indicate that so that we can make your call a priority.
