Dress Code Options for 2014-2015 School Year

Purpose: To help create a learning environment in which student learning is the primary focus.

Non-negotiable

- No form fitting clothing, spandex pants • or Jeggins
- No sheer/transparent/see through • clothing (tops or bottoms)
- No torn, ripped garments with holes •
- No oversized or baggy pants •
- No high/low skirts or dresses •
- No Bandanas/Hats • (Nothing that *ties* around the head)
- No visible undergarment (tops or bottoms) •
- No cleavage showing
- No pajamas •

Clarifications: White or light colored pants, shorts, jeans or skirts may be worn, but must NOT be see through.



Acceptable

Tops

- Collar, button down, and crew neck shirts (NO V-neckline) (Patterns permitted)
- Polo shirts
- School shirts
- No exposed midriff.

Bottoms

- Khakis pants, jeans, shorts, and skirts (Patterns permitted)
- All items worn at the waist (Belts when needed)
- All bottoms must be knee length or longer •
- No torn, baggy, form fitting clothing allowed *All other aspects of PCSB dress code guidelines are in effect

Shoes: Remain consistent with PCSB Student Code of Conduct.

Exceptions: None
