#### Required Dress for Countryside High School graduation:

<u>Men</u> must wear a collared dress shirt (preferably white) with a necktie (preferably dark), socks (preferably dark) and dress shoes.

<u>Women</u> should wear a dress that is not visible at the gowns neckline, cuff or hemline. Pant suits are acceptable. Purses should be kept with your parents.

Gowns look much nicer when they are pressed. Faculty and staff will check each student for appropriate attire, appearance and demeanor. <u>No</u> paraphernalia, such as corsages, etc., may be worn on the gown.

# <u>Senior Survey</u> <u>Must be completed by all seniors</u>

### Instructions for Completing the Senior Survey

Students will be completing the survey via their Office 365 account (every student in PSC has their own account).

- 1. Students must log onto the school computer with their username and password.
- 2. Students should log onto the internet using either Google Chrome or Firefox.
- 3. Students will go to the following web address: <u>http://tinyurl.com/pcssenior</u>.
- 4. They will be taken to the Office 365 login page.
- 5. If they have never logged into their 365 account, they will need to enter their email address which is <u>their R2.D2 number @pcsb.org</u> (including the period).
- 6. After they enter the email, they will click in the password box but will not enter a password at that time.
- 7. They will be redirected to a pop-up and students will enter their R2.D2 (but not @pcsb.org) and the password will be the same as Focus (s. last 8 digits of their local ID).
- 8. Once they have successfully logged in, they will be taken to the survey.
- 9. Once they have completed the survey, their answer will be recorded.
