

- 1. On your locker assignment day, you can purchase a lock or use a Countryside High School lock from previous years as long as the number on the back of the lock is a V70 or V638.
- 2. If you have previously purchased a Countryside High School lock, you must bring your lock and combination with you on your locker assignment day. You will be asked to put the lock on your locker immediately!
- 3. If you need to purchase a lock, it is \$4.00 cash only! Exact cash is appreciated!
- 4. If you will not be able to attend your locker assignment day, you can have a friend/parent/other relative get your locker assignment for you.
  - Your friend/parent/other relative will need a signed letter from you giving them permission to get your locker assignment.
  - They must bring your lock and combination to the locker assignment day

### GRADUATION INFORMATON

Graduation will be held on May 23, 2019 at Tropicana Field from 11:00 a.m. to 1:00 p.m. There are two separate fees for graduation:

- 1. Cap/Gown, and Diploma Cover Varies with package you choose. Please, see order form.

- > Graduation announcements are an extra fee.
- 2. <u>Graduation Fees</u> \$45 Check or Cash (Checks made payable to Countryside High School.) Checks will be accepted until April 26, 2019, then only cash will be accepted.

Graduations fees paid on Tuesday and Fridays during both lunches by the front office.

- > Graduation fees can by paid by cash or check (checks would be payable to Countryside High School.
- > This fee covers the venue site at the Tropicana Field in St. Petersburg and other costs related to the ceremony.
- > Extra gold forms can be found in the front office.

## Additional Important Information:

3. Every senior must fill out the Gold Application for Graduation form whether you are walking or not. If you need a copy of the gold form, you can find it in the front office.

Required Dress for Countryside High School graduation:

- Men must wear a collared dress shirt (preferably white) with a necktie (preferably dark), socks (preferably dark) and dress shoes, and dark trousers (no jeans or casual pants allowed).
- Women should wear a dress that is not visible at the gown's neckline, cuff or hemline. Pantsuits are acceptable. Purses should be kept with parents.
  Gowns look much nicer when they are pressed. No paraphernalia such as corsages, etc. may be worn on the gown.
- > Faculty and staff will check each student for appropriate attire, appearance and demeanor.

- 4. Information about parking, the appropriate entrance to use, and other misc. information will be distributed in early May 2019 at the graduation rehearsal held in the auditorium of Countryside High School. Tickets are not required to attend graduation at Tropicana Field, and there is no limit to the number of guests who can attend.
- 5. If you have any obligations such as textbooks, library books or other fees owed to the school, you must pay by check (payable to Countryside High School), cash or money order. Checks will only be accepted for fees of \$30.00 or more; otherwise, you must pay by cash or money order. Checks will be accepted until April 26, 2019. After that, only cash will be accepted.
- 6. If you want to attend Prom and Senior Breakfast, all obligations must be paid to attend the event. If you want to find out if you have any textbook obligations, please, contact Lonnette Alexander at <a href="mailto:alexanderlo@pcsb.org">alexanderlo@pcsb.org</a>
  Checks will be accepted until April 26, 2019. After that, only cash will be accepted.
