With new found knowledge about the natural resources all around us here in Florida you will want to get out and explore them!

Mineral Mania - Investigate the earth, build volcanoes and devise ways to classify rocks and minerals. Experience the thrill of panning for gold and other gems to take home!

Earth Awareness - Come up with pollution solutions in a water filter building competition. Make a brown cloud and get tangled in trash. Take home a super-absorbent soil substitute—jelly orbs!

Life In The Sea - What is life like under the ocean's surface? Examine and investigate various sea creatures, explore the deep, dark depths of our oceans and learn about buoyancy and adaptation. Make your own Cartesian Diver!

Where's the Air? - Explore the concepts of air pressure and crush a can using hot water. Meet our trusty assistant Egbert. Experience vortices and find out what a vacuum is all about.

All About Animals - Discover the unique features of animals by examining teeth, claws and fur. Students will explore ways in which animals adapt to the challenging elements of their environment. Make your own animal tracks to take home!

Ecosystems - Explore the elements of energy webs, find out why plants are green and reflect on how we affect ecosystems. Build your own living mini ecosystem!

Grossology - Celebrate cells and unravel the mysteries of the basic building blocks of all living things. Explore the gross science of our own body systems by making brain goo, mucus, and other fun yucky stuff. Create a tasty but gross model cell to take home!

Bugs! - Discover what makes our creepy crawly friends unique; their fabulous flying abilities, their special eyesight, and the way that they defend themselves against predators. Explore how bugs can see by taking home your own Insect-a-vision!
