Tips for Conferences

BEFORE YOU GO

- Find out how your child feels about school - favorite & least favorite subject
- Review your child's midterms
- Make a list of anything you want to tell the teacher. (This could be information to help the teacher better understand your child, or any problems from outside of school that may be affecting your child.)

DURING THE CONFERENCE

- If you don't understand an educational term, don't hesitate to ask what it means. (We sometimes forget we speak our own language.)
- Ask about homework and what role you should take.
- Ask how your child is adjusting socially.
- Discuss how to resolve any problems

AFTER THE CONFERENCE

- Follow up on all suggestions the teacher makes.
- Keep track of your child's progress with the use of Campus.
- Regularly review classwork, homework, and tests.
- Keep in touch with your child's teacher. You do not need to wait until a formal conference to express concerns.
