 (If you do not have a SSN, you must complete a hardcopy undergraduate application by visiting an SPC Business Office on campus with photo ID, and identifying as a prospective dual enrollment student.)
 - O Apply using your full name (no nicknames), and check for misspellings. **Also ensure the accuracy of your SSN and date of birth,** as these are used for verification in the login process.
 - Under High School Information, be sure to select your correct high school from the drop-down list, including city and state.
