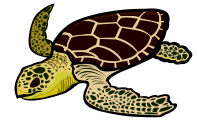
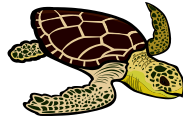

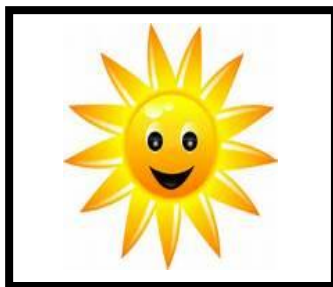

We are so proud of everyone's hard work and look forward to celebrating the remainder of our FSA results when they are released.

ready to learn. Many of our staff members will be busy attending professional development, again planning for the implementation of challenging curriculum and hopefully enjoying some well-deserved downtime!
