

#### \*Summer Safety

Summer is a favorite time of year for children and adults of all ages. The long days of summer are often filled with swimming, cookouts, travel and outdoor fun. But summer can also carry danger for children. Drowning incidents increase during the summer months, and the hot sun puts kids at risk of sunburn, dehydration and heat-related illness.

Whether kids enjoy summer at home, on the road or at camp, below are some safety tips to keep your family healthy and happy.

\*Follow pool rules and closely supervise children when in or around the water.

- \*Make sure children take water breaks and wear lightweight clothing when playing outside. Learn to recognize the signs of heat stroke.
- \*Drink plenty of water to avoid dehydration.
- \*Protect your skin from sun. Apply sun screen with SPF 30 or higher, reapply every three hours.
- \*Enjoy fireworks safely to prevent injury.

These are a few ways you can stay safe, prevent injury and accidents while having fun in the sun.
