Kiwanis leader, Janine Brown, a 38-year veteran teacher, was amazed at the in depth questions asked by the fully engaged K-Kids. The inquiries ranged from length of stay to security measures to protection of other relatives, particularly grandmothers.

Over the next several Fridays, K-Kids will make decorations, choose and wrap gifts, and arrange food and entertainment for The Haven party. SHES's own Mrs. Carstensen has agreed to provide music and lead the kids in dancing.
