Dear Safety Harbor Families,

Thank you for a wonderful opening to our school year! Thank you also for your commitment to support your child's success by: reviewing their agenda books daily, checking grades on FOCUS, reinforcing expectations and communicating with the classroom teacher, joining and participating, when possible, in events sponsored by our dedicated PTA. Our first couple events, Mornings with Mom and the PTA Information Meeting, following our Kindergarten and Pre-K Open House were well organized and well attended! Please be sure you are looking out for our Reading Night / PTA Dinner invite which is always a big hit! We look forward to seeing everyone on September 17<sup>th</sup>!

Now that everyone is familiar with arrival and dismissal processes, we have just a couple of minor suggestions to make things go more smoothly. Please refrain from using cell phones and/or smoking in the car line. Pull up to the most available loading/unloading space in the circle, leave no space between you and the car in front of you, and finally, have a dashboard sign with your student's name printed in large letters. Thank you to those parents who are being patient and courteous to staff members and fellow parents as we safely load and unload students each day. Another important topic to consider this time of year is student safety when arriving or departing from school or the bus stop. If meeting primary students, arrive to the bus stop on time and practice walking your route with your child.

Communicating behavior expectations for your scholars is extremely important as well. Our Safety Harbor Sea Turtle Traits are reinforced and celebrated throughout the campus and the school day! Commitment to character traits that make up our Guidelines for Success include: Safety First, Being Respectful, and Being Responsible and Ready to Learn! Each month at our Sea Turtle Character Assembly we celebrate students nominated by their teachers for demonstrating our character trait of the month on a consistent basis.

Finally families, MAP (Measures of Academic Progress) Testing begins next week. This is our district common assessment that is given 3 times a year to gauge growth and progress. ## Find out now if your student's bus is going to be delayed

Pinellas County Schools Transportation Department is implementing a new system to inform you when your child's bus is going to be delayed. Our school is part of a pilot effort to use a system called Bus Bulletin.

The Bus Bulletin notification system will notify schools, parents and students when there are bus delays and schedule changes. If you would like to receive instant notifications when delays or incidents affect your student's bus, please register with Bus Bulletin.

- There is no cost to you for this service.
- Registration is simple and fast.
- You can choose to receive either text messages, phone calls, and e-mails or all of these options.
- All contact information is stored securely and will not be shared or sold. Your privacy is protected.
- Please note: this system is not related to Pinellas County Schools new emergency text message communications through SchoolMessenger.
