## Community Service



- ◆ Student must find an agency that meets the Bright Future Program’s qualifications.
- ◆ Student must fill out the community service proposal form. All hours **must** be approved by Mrs. Mullaney **prior** to completing service hours.
- ◆ During community service, students must complete community service log.
- ◆ Upon completion of hours, student must:
  - ⇒ Have agency contact sign-off on hours
  - ⇒ Complete reflection form
  - ⇒ Turn approved proposal form, service log and reflection form into guidance office/Mrs. Faustino.
