In these difficult times, the school counselors will not be able to complete visits to the middle schools this spring for students to finalize their course requests for the 2020-2021 school year.

The counseling team is requesting that you sit with your son and/or daughter to select the courses they would like to take next year. Northeast has a seven period a day school, so students would need to have that many courses selected.

Some students will already have some courses predetermined for them. An example would be students in one of our academies (AOF, AOIT, Culinary, AMTC). A student who also <u>did not</u> receive a passing FSA score from grade 7 would need to take a comprehensive reading course as required by the county.

Most, if not all students will have four core courses they will choose:

English: English 1 – regular or honors, or English 2 honors
Math: Algebra 1a (Lowest offered), Algebra 1, or Geometry honors (if student has algebra 1 already)
Science: Environmental science honors (Lowest offered) or Biology honors
Social Studies: World history – regular, honors or AP
Students will then choose their electives based on the number of the seven course slots remaining open.
