#### **Student / Parent Responsibilities** (please initial to confirm the requirement is met):

\_\_\_ / \_\_\_ Student must apply as a degree-seeking student to USF.

\_\_\_ / \_\_\_ Students applying for early admission at USF must meet the GPA requirement (3.8) as calculated by USF. USF has final approval on accepting students for early admission.

\_\_\_ / \_\_\_ It is the student's responsibility to submit all required paperwork directly to USF by the published deadline on the USF Early University Program website.

\_\_\_ / \_\_\_ Must meet minimum required test score of 1300 on SAT, with at least 580 in Critical Reading, or 29 on ACT, with at least a 29 in English (Student's responsibility to officially submit test scores to USF).

\_\_\_ / \_\_\_ Student and parent are aware that credits and grades earned through early admission will be part of the student's permanent high school and college record/transcript.

\_\_\_ / \_\_\_ Student and parent understand that early admission students interact with college students in a college campus environment with academic and social challenges.

\_\_\_ / \_\_\_ Early admission students are not packaged with aid (e.g., admissions scholarships, federal grants, etc.) until the first year after high school. Students are typically packaged in April of their first-year at USF for subsequent years; should a student decide to attend another college, they will receive a funding package according to that school's timeline.

\_\_\_ / \_\_\_ Under Florida statute (F.S. 1007.271), early admission students are not held responsible for their tuition. Tuition and instructional materials are covered by the student's school district or charter school. Tuition is covered by the student's private school. All students are responsible for cost such as ID, transcripts, parking, if needed; they are also responsible for room and board if campus residency is desired.

\_\_\_ / \_\_\_ Student must provide the college schedule to the high school.

\_\_\_ / \_\_\_ Early admission students must enroll as a full-time college student (12-15 credit hours each semester) and complete the high school courses required for a standard high school diploma.

\_\_\_ / \_\_\_ If attempting to meet the requirements for the Florida Bright Futures Scholarship Program, it is the student's responsibility to verify the courses in which he/she is enrolled will meet the scholarship requirements.
