Gold Seal Scholarship

- Initial eligibility requirements as of July 2017 are:
- Achieve the required weighted minimum GPA of a 3.0 in the non-elective high school courses;
- Take at least three full credits in a single Career and Technical Education program;
- Achieve the required 3.5 unweighted GPA in the career education courses;
- Achieve the required minimum score on the ACT, SAT or P.E.R.T.; AND
- Complete 30 service hours.

The required test scores are:

- ACT Reading 19
- ACT English 17
- ACT Mathematics 19

SAT (Prior to March 2016)

- Critical Reading 440
- Mathematics 440

SAT (March 1, 2016 and thereafter)

- Reading Test 24
- Writing & Language Test 25
- Math Test 24

P.E.R.T. (applies only to Gold Seal)

- Reading 106
- Writing 103
- Mathematics 114
