- Attendance is very important, please be sure your student is here, healthy, each
 day. If your student is running a fever or showing other symptoms of sickness,
 please keep them home to recover, contact your alpha clerk with any absences or
 requests to leave.
- Be sure that your student is in **dress code daily**, here are a few reminders:
- Form fitting leotard/spandex type clothing (i.e. leggings/yoga pants) are not allowed unless proper outer garments cover to mid-thigh length or longer, if there is a question its best to wear alternative pants.
- Clothing must cover the body from one armpit across to the other armpit and down to mid-thigh. All tops must have sleeves, cover the entire shoulder, and mid-drift.

- ALL shoes must have a back, this includes Crocs, bedroom slippers are not permitted.
- ALL cellphones, earbuds, and headphones are to be away during instructional time. During transition times students are permitted to use their cellphones only, earbuds and headphones are permitted before and after school and during lunch in the lunchroom only. When appropriately using earbuds or headphones one ear must always remain free of the accessory.
- Students must be on time to class each period. Please remind your students of the importance of timeliness.
- Student drivers, please be cautious when entering and exiting the student parking lot, we have had many complaints of reckless driving, if you cannot be appropriate in the student parking lot, parking privileges will be revoked.
