- Thank you for your continued support as we work through our unique situation. Please be reminded that morning drop off has never changed, please **use** the **south car circle** in the morning for student drop off, this will elevate traffic in the student parking and will assist getting students to get to class on time, 7:00am. In the afternoon, student pick up does not begin until **12, noon**. You may not enter any pickup location until that time. After 12 noon you will be able to enter either the student parking lot or the south car circle to pick up your student. Please trust the process and we will move through drop off and pick up much more smoothly.
