

News and Notes- Gentle Reminders!

- Please ensure that all phone numbers are up-to-date at school and in Focus.
- Please be sure to check and sign your child's agenda, daily.
- Students being picked-up early, should be minimized, to maximize learning. For those that are necessary, please do so before 2:00PM to avoid the afternoon dismissal concerns.
- We need all learners in class by 8:35AM each day. Please help us reduce student tardies at school.
- Please maintain regular communication with your child's teacher and attend scheduled conferences to stay abreast of your child's progress.
- When visiting the campus, be it for a conference or to eat with your students, be sure you are signing in with our front office and getting a visitors pass.
- Remember the front lot of the school is for buses only from 8:05-8:45am & 2:00-3:00pm. If you are parked in the bus circle during that time, for the safety of our students, you will have to wait until they depart before pulling out so you may want to park in the parent parking lot instead.

- Sibling priority doesn't guarantee your child a seat; just a position higher in the lottery.
- <u>Current students at BPE do not need to reapply</u>

Acceptance Period: February 3rd-10th

- Be sure to go in and check your invitations
- You must select one or remain on the wait list for your others. If you do not accept a seat that is offered during the acceptance window, your application with that program is erased


