NOTICE: School Health Screenings

School Health Services for 2012-13

School nurses identify and assist students with health-care needs during the school day. Every school has a school nurse assigned either full or part time. A clinic card is sent home with each student at the beginning of every school year. Please complete the cards promptly with the important health and contact information and update the information as often as needed.

Medications should be taken at home whenever possible. If medications (both prescription and over the counter) are required at school, a medication card (available from your school) must be completed each year. No student may transport medications to or from school.

The Pinellas County School District, in accordance with Florida State Statutes (s.381.0056(6)(e), FS, provides health services and screenings for students in the public The schools. services may include medication administration (in accordance with district policy), and first aid for illness or injury. The screenings may include, vision, hearing, BMI (Body mass index- height and weight), scoliosis (gr 6 only), and any appropriate followup. If you do not want your child to participate in any of these services and/or screenings and be exempted, please notify your school/school nurse in writing.

Our school's screening day is scheduled for Kindergarten and First Grade Vision & Hearing and Third Grade Vision only on November 26, 2012. Students in grade 6 will also be screened for scoliosis. If you do not want your child to participate in these screenings, you must notify the school/ school nurse in writing, and specify which screenings you want to "opt-out" of.

District Wide Changes for Volunteers

The School Board requires that any one who has unsupervised contact with students be fingerprinted (Level II clearance).

- All volunteers, which includes guest speakers, must be registered volunteers and background checked.
- All volunteers must sign in at the front desk and log into Focus to record their hours for the day.
- Volunteers who have unsupervised contact with students must be Level II cleared. This includes:
 - 1. Field trip drivers
 - 2. All chaperones attending overnight field trips
- Classroom volunteers must not be left alone with students.
- Those who wish to obtain Level II clearance must first be registered volunteers. Go to EZFingerPrints http://www.ezfingerprints.com to set an appointment. The fee is \$48.00. Approval takes up to 72 hours.
- Individuals who currently have a Level II clearance (police officers, firefighters, nurses, school board employees) may provide a copy of the Level II badge/ card or VECHS/FDLE paperwork to: The Office of Strategic Partnerships, 301 Fourth Street, Largo, FL 33770 - 727-588-6000 x 1853
- All Level II screened volunteers must carry in their possession their Level II badge when volunteering.

Parents were given a password and user ID. The user ID begins with "p." and is followed by your name. The password is generated by the district, and is case sensitive. Please keep it in a safe place so that you are able to access your child's information.

Volunteers Must Reactivate

Volunteers must reactivate in the computer. Usually the user ID is "v." followed by your last name, first initial (e.g. v.smithp). Your password is your last name (capitalize the first letter) followed by your four digit year of birth (e.g. Smith2012). Once you have reactivated you will not have to fill out paperwork again for this school year.
