MAGNET CONTRACT AND TARDIES

If you have had a chance to review the 2011/2012 School Improvement Plan, (http://www.flbsi.org/SIP/) you are aware that there is a goal for attendance. You saw that for last year the number of students with excessive absences (10 or more) was 160 and excessive tardies (10 or more) was 211.

The Magnet Contract that is signed by all students and parents states in order to remain at Bay Point, a child is expected to attend school promptly and regularly with limited absences and tardies. Often times a student's attendance affects their academic achievement. This in turn affects the overall performance of our school. Although we enjoy having you as part of the Bay Point family, it might be time for you to reevaluate whether you and your child can continue to fulfill your contractual agreement to remain at Bay Point.

A student can be nominated for Gifted by either the classroom teacher or the parent. The first step in the process is for the nominating person to fill out a gifted nomination Alert form. Teachers can give the form to parents, and then it is given to our Guidance Counselor, Ms. Tetro. Once she receives the completed form, Ms. Tetro will send home a Parent Notification of Screening for Gifted letter. She will also give the Alert to the gifted teacher. Our gifted teachers are given one day per month to cancel classes and screen potential students. Once the screening is completed, the gifted teacher will send home the Parent Notice of Gifted Screening Results. If the student receives a qualifying score on the screening, Ms. Tetro will send home a Consent for Evaluation and the additional forms that are required by Pinellas County to determine eligibility for Gifted. A school psychologist has 90 school days from the consent date to give the child an intelligence/IQ test.

Please encourage your child to continue reading over the break.
