## PCS Virtual School

Virtual school education is expanding across the state of Florida as a result of the Digital Learning Act. This legislation allows students in grades K-12 to take online classes through Pinellas Virtual School, either full time or part time. Students who enter high school in 2011-12 and beyond, which includes current 9th graders, are required to complete at least one online course as part of their graduation requirements.

The first registration period for Pinellas Virtual School is open until July 20, 2012 for all Pinellas County Schools students who wish to take an online class.
